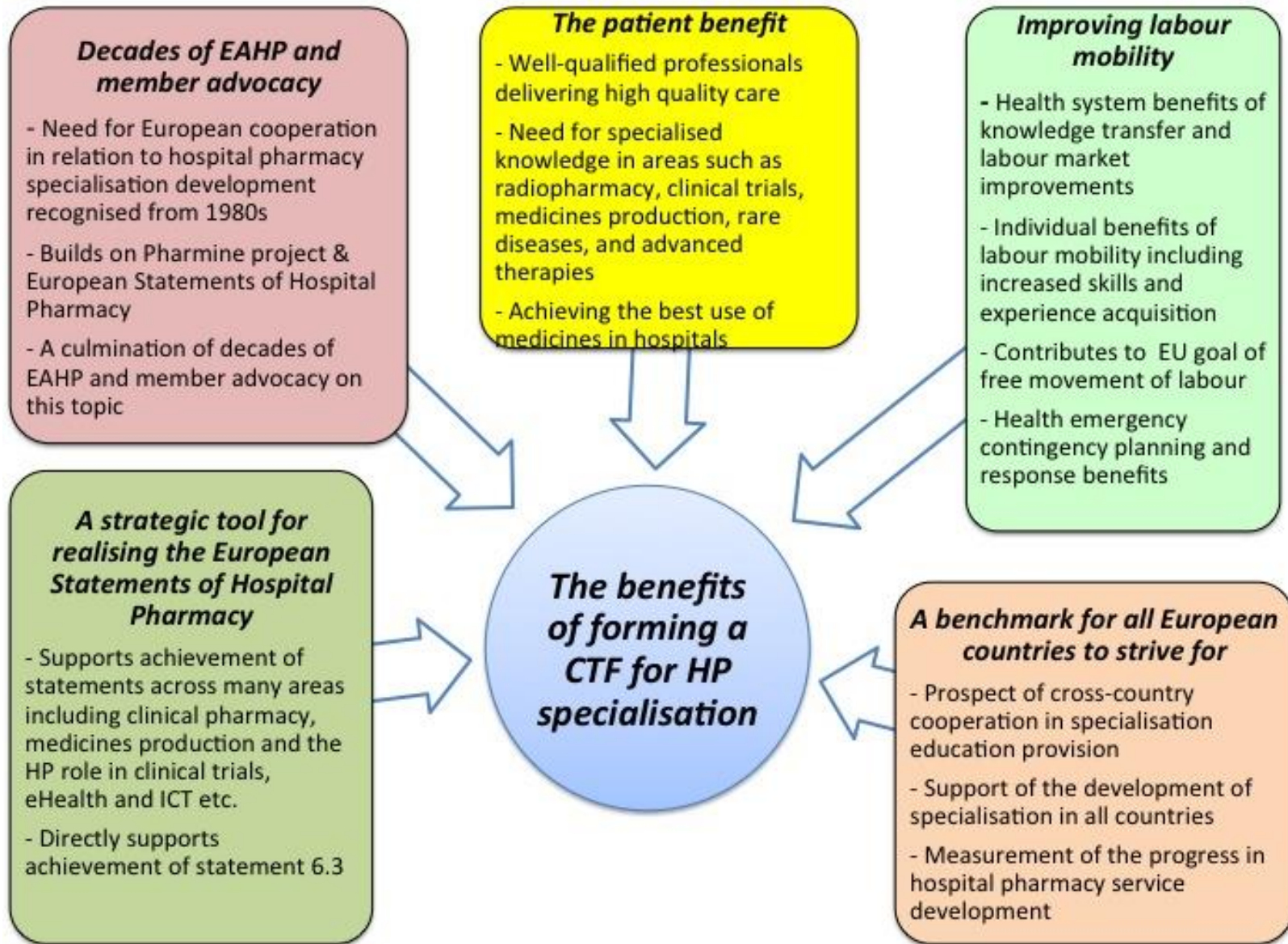


EAHP's Common Training Framework Project

European Statements of Hospital Pharmacy

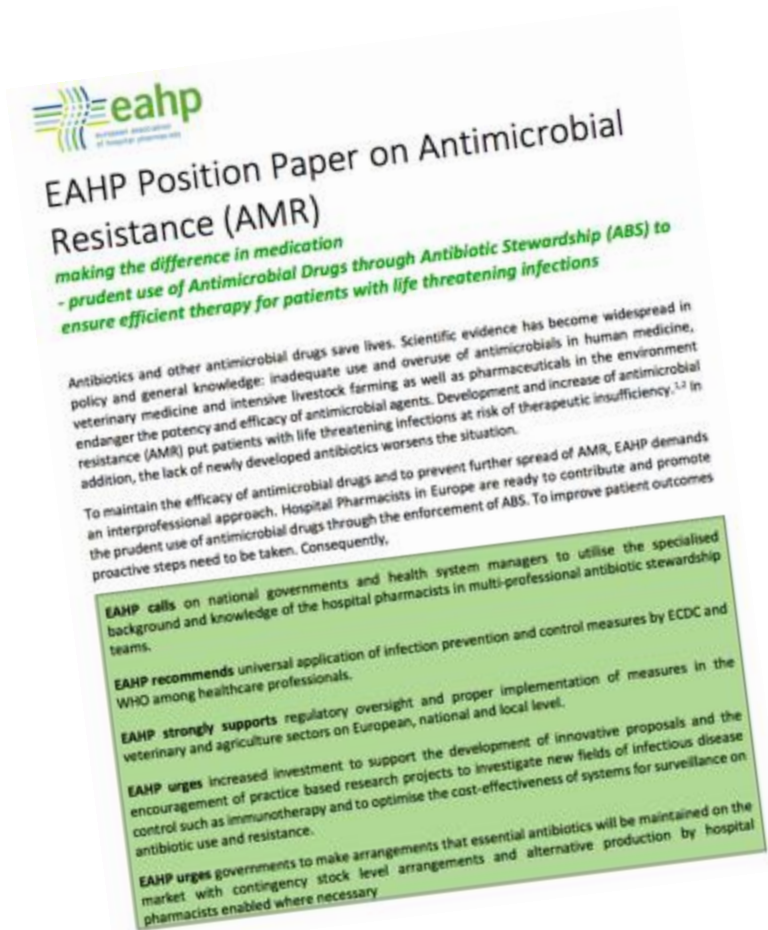
Express commonly agreed objectives which an health system should aim for in the delivery of services
